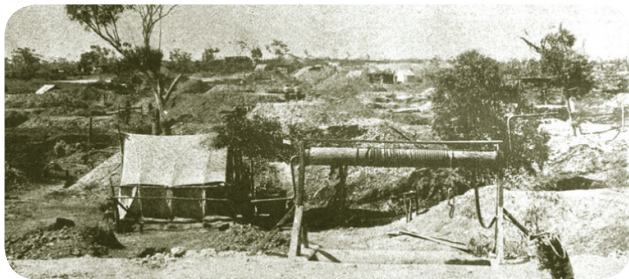

The Eastern Goldfields Historical Society was established in 1946 and boasts a large collection of historical Goldfields photographs and documents as well as a range of books on the Goldfields and Western Australia, including local histories, biographies, maps and reference material.

The Society also holds numerous objects and collections of historical significance to this vast region, as well as indexes on pioneers, mining heritage, outback towns, heritage buildings, cemeteries, post office directories and electoral rolls.



The Eastern Goldfields Historical Society covers one of the biggest local history regions in the world—320,000 square kilometres of Western Australia, including many important regional towns and centres such as Kalgoorlie-Boulder, Coolgardie, Kambalda, Leonora, Gwalia, Laverton, Norseman, Leinster, Wiluna, Menzies and Sandstone.

Hundreds of abandoned gold rush towns and mining centres are scattered throughout the Goldfields and their stories contribute to the vibrant history of our region.
